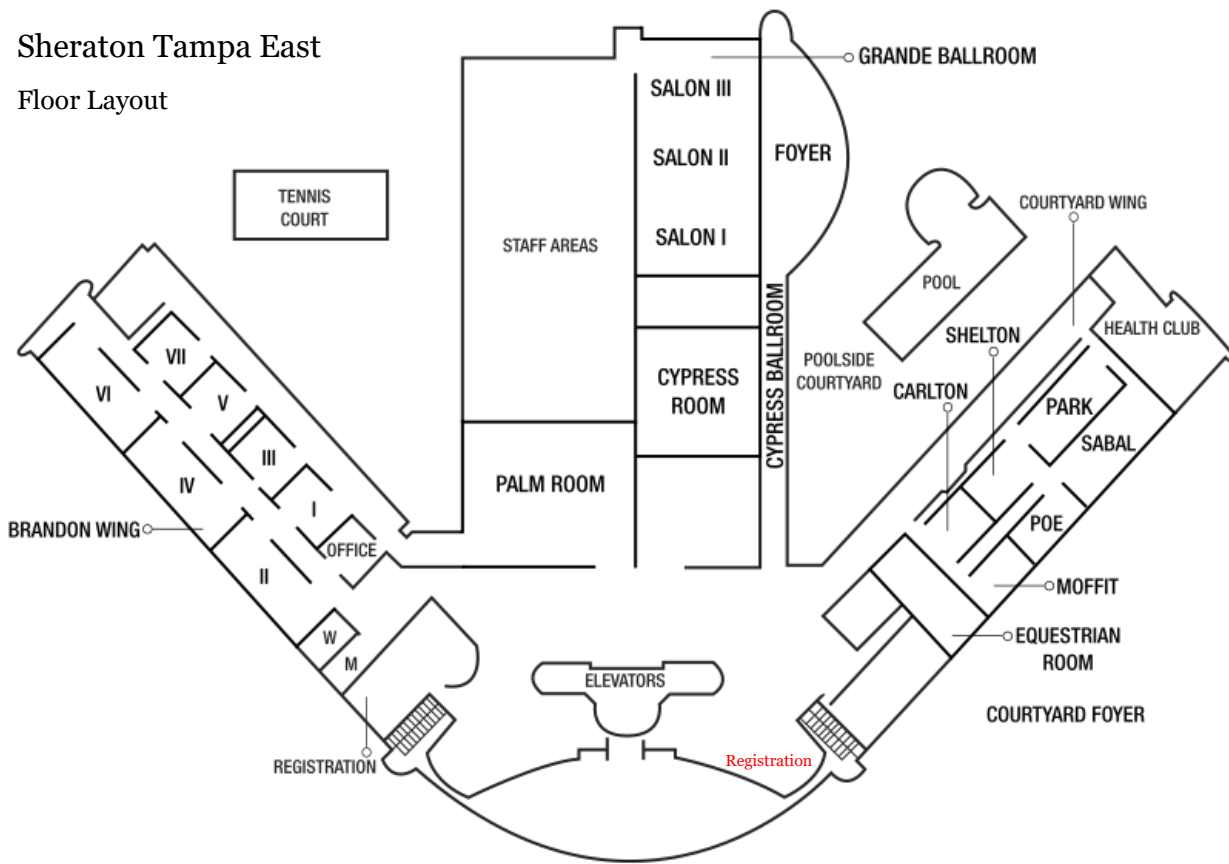


## Sheraton Tampa East
